2022 Monthly Income Guidelines

Family Size	Monthly Income Limit
1	\$1,133
2	\$1,526
3	\$1,919
4	\$2,313
5	\$2,706
6	\$3,099
7	\$3,493
8	\$3,886

For families with more than 8 persons,
add \$393 for each additional person.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Your child(ren) must be between the ages of newborn and 16 as of October 1, 2022. (Note: Foster children are **not** eligible.)
- Your household must meet Federal Poverty levels for its size. (See chart.)

You must provide the following:

- A copy of your state ID or drivers license
- Social Security numbers for all household members
- Proof of household income for the last 30 days - this can include check stubs from employers, benefit letter from MDHHS, Unemployment Agency, Social Security, or documentation of child support amounts, etc.

Children will be served in order received.

If your child(ren) received Warm the Children in 2021, they are not eligible for for the program in 2022.
