**Baw Beese Trail:** 8.2 miles of asphalt surfacing with end points located at: Sandy Beach Park on Lakeview Dr. (Hillsdale) and Olds St./SR 99 and W. Chicago St./US 12 (Jonesville). Trail activities: bike, inline skating, fishing, wheelchair accessible, walking, cross-country skiing.
